March 19th, 2019

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed . . . available upon request. Approximately 92 Members paid for 2019.

Runway/Field Improvement Update: AMA Field Improvement Grant has been submitted and waiting on decision from AMA. City of Omaha meeting on 3/13; Rick and Luke in attendance. Confirmation of approval to be submitted to City Council and Mayor in next 3 weeks to grind and resurface the 500 foot runway with a 2" overlay, striping, gate and chain link fence to be added along road to further restrict unwanted access.

Meeting Topics: Runway construction schedule; 2 weeks of field shutdown for grinding and resurfacing [May]. Chain-link fencing; American Fence will start soon and will not be a factor. Picnic table rehab; email Dennis Bryers (Parks) list and he'll have them "swapped out" [emailed on 3/18] Signage; entry and dock/hawk field at fork, by the City. PR Event; Speak with Tracy @ Parks and Rec regarding upcoming/possible event coordination.

Omahawks fund for runway to be utilized for repairs/upkeep in addition to City's repaving. Up to \$5,000 to be requested by members at the General Meeting held on 3/22; funds to be used for materials in construction/improvement items (see attached).

Cole Meyo was appointed as Field Chairman for 2019 by unanimous vote. Another Board Member will need to be elected by membership.

Ed Paasch presented a "New Member Quick Fact Sheet" to give to any interested person who wants to become a club member. Copies will be made available for members and at field.

First big push for new members recommended to be in May when weather turns warm.

June Offutt AFB Airshow cancelled due to flooding.

The use of AMA's SIM trailer at Labor Day was discussed. Voted not to proceed due to cost and distraction factor.

Program: Ron Van Oeveren-brief history of the runway and Hawk Field. Raffle prizes and show and tell.

RIP fellow flyer, friend - Art Miller passed at age 91 on March 19, 2019


