
### **A Blustery and Cold Winterfest 2015**

# Omahawks agreement/contract with the city of Omaha

The contract between the Omahawks and the City of Omaha was initiated in 1986 and was originally set to expire in 2001. In 1998 the Omahawks requested and was granted an extension ending December 31, 2016. The Board of Directors has reviewed the current contract and we have a few recommended changes that we plan to present to the city.

A copy of the changes has been placed on the Omahawks web site in the members only area. Look for the "Document Library" on the right side of the page. The revised contract is labeled "City AGREEMENT 2015 rev A TC"

The club will discuss these changes at the March general membership meeting with the intention of approving the changes and presenting them to the city for approval. A summary of the changes is presented below.

- Credits the Omahawks for paying off the original loan
- **Gives** the Omahawks Board of Directors the responsibility/ authority to develop rules and establish user fee instead of the Parks and Recreation Department.
- **Remove** statement that says field funds have to be spent on the field and the Parks and Recreation Department has the authority/responsibility to approve any expenditures.
- **Remove** discussion of rent payment. The original agreement called for \$3600 rent per year from 1989 to 2001. These payments are no longer required.
- Add a statement indicating the city will assist or allow Omahawks to remove trees and shrubs that affect safe use of the field. This includes obstruction of view or air turbulence caused by trees.
- **Remove** statement indicating that the field may be used for other purposes when not used as a flying facility.

Remember: If you would like to ask about a section or append an area of this contract, we will be going over this contract on Friday, March 27th to get your input on these proposals, and this would be the time to voice your concerns on this important documentation.


