

### Passing.

Sadly, two long time club members passed away earlier this winter – Bob Burt and Tom Shapland. Both were active Omahawk members for many years and they will be missed. Dick Behrens provided this commentary.

#### Robert Burt 1936-2015

Bob Burt passed away on November 23, 2015 in Omaha at the age of 79. He had been battling heart problems in recent years and had major surgeries for this. He was born May 8, 1936, in Vallejo, California. His father was in the Navy at that time. Their family later moved to Virginia, where he graduated from Norview HS in 1954. He then attended Lincoln University in Tennessee. He served in the US Air Force 1958-1962. He was stationed In Okinawa and later in Sioux City, where he met his wife. They had been married for over 50 years and had three children.

Bob joined the Omahawks in 1998, after he retired. He was a morning flyer at Hawkfield and flew his models in many area events. He was a regular at float fly, old timer, glider, cross country, and Labor Day Show events; and also a regular at HyVee breakfasts on Tuesday mornings. For five years, he flew at both the north Omaha airport before large crowds preceding the July 4 fireworks; and at SIG's annual fun flys at Montezuma, Iowa. He was also certified as an AMA contest director.

Bob was a helpful, prompt, and knowledgeable person. He was considered an early bird at events and had a hardy laugh. He will be missed.





#### Tom Shapland 1934-2015

Tom was a former Omahawk who also flew with the morning flyers. He joined the club after he retired. Tom passed away on Nov 19, 2015 at the age of 81. He had graduated from Omaha's North High school and Iowa State. He learned to fly quickly with a Senioritta that he built. Tom arranged and served pancakes for the morning flyers many times. He also arranged morning events at Hawkfield for young children to learn something about RC planes. His wife, Flo, had a sewing machine that she used to embroider the names of morning flyers on their white tennis shirts, free of charge.

#### Hawk Field:
