History Note (From Dick Behrens, with input from Larry Quigley and Skip Brown). Thirty years ago this summer (1986), a few Omahawk members noticed a real estate for sale sign just north of Fort Street near what is now 138th street. This land would have been farm land at one time; however, in mid 1986 small bushes and trees were growing there. This land was just south and adjacent to another piece of land ("Parcel A") that had been acquired by the Corps of Engineers for dam site #16, which had been built in 1972-73. The parcel for sale was eleven acres and had been referred to as "Parcel B". Some Omahawks members quickly decided to see if they could buy these eleven acres to expand Parcel A, which had been used by local RC flyers including Omahawk members. They realized time was important as housing developers would want to buy and build houses on this land.

To find out what the owner wanted and to negotiate a sale of the eleven acres, Ollie Olson (Omahawk newsletter editor) and Ron Vanovern (Omahawk president) quickly flew to Colorado to talk to the land owners (Patricia & Robert Bowen). The negotiated price was \$42,000. To come up with this money, they borrowed some from a bank (\$28,500 from DCL&T) and formed and sold shares in a new land company (Hawk Land Co). There were 46 people who held shares in the land company. The Hawk Land Co. paid the Bowens \$42,027.74 some time that year, and then leased it to the Omahawks.

Last year, Larry Quigley, the land company secretary, gave me the 46 notes of the shares for disposal. Larry had obtained these notes from Olie's wife, after Olie passed away in July 2008. This is an important part of how Hawkfield came to be.

Ralston Toy & Train Show (from Rick Sessions): We had a good exhibit and decent traffic flow to our booth on Saturday. Not sure about Sunday as I was not there (out of town). We handed out a lot of club brochures and will see if we get any interest from this effort.



#### Field Update:

- Bernie noted that we have not received the lease document we were expecting from the city Parks Department. He

  felt it would good to have them experience first-hand one of our community activities.
- Our field chair has a call in Mr. Anderson with the city regarding help moving parking lot aggregate back up the hill and filling some of the wash outs.

**Old Business:** The president had posted some changes to our Field Rules for members to review before a vote.   carried unanimously.
- On June 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> there will be an opportunity to participate the Train and Toy Show at the Ralston Arena. A 20'x40' area with tables will be available to the Omahawks for static displays. So mark it on your calendar and let Rick Sessions know if you can participate. It is a good opportunity to promote our hobby and our club.
