

SAFETY CORNER:

Accidents don't happen just at the field.

Many mishaps occur away from the field and proper attention to safety is required wherever you are working on your R/C stuff. While building or repairing your planes, always keep a look out for potential problems and always make safety your number one priority.

Good safety practices include keeping your hobby knife away from the edge of the work bench/table.

Using a holding stand for your covering and trim irons. And, be sure they're cooled down before putting them away. Be sure your flammable items are kept sealed and away from ignition sources.

When charging your LiPo batteries, always use the proper charger and charging precautions.

Sometimes, you just need to play the pessimist, and think, "What if..." This will help keep your work area safe and could possibly save a catastrophic accident from damaging your home. Keep your aircraft in good repair, and you'll enjoy the experience much more. Have a safe flight day, E.J. Murphy
