Meeting called to order: President Mikey Furrow

Treasurer's report: Kevin Hyde presented the Treasurers Report dated Sept 2nd, 2015.

Membership Chair report: President Farrow reported that membership stands at 134 which is an increase year over year.

Hawk Field:

- <u>Status of the long term lease</u>: Bernie Baker stated the proposed contract has been passed on to the City Attorney's office for a final review. Last week he sent a note to Steven Slater, who is our contact at the city, in an effort to let them know that we are "patiently" waiting news.
- <u>General Field</u>: Bob Wheeler, Gary V and Dennis were at the field with some Scouts doing general trimming and clearing some small trees around the location for the Port Potties. Bob also has started looking at the schedule for submitting a request for city grant money to help the club with runway improvement.
- Runway renovation: There were further discussions regarding the condition of the runway. General consensus was that the test area for crack filling completed last month looked positive. The next step proposed for this same area of the runway was to apply a seal coat to protect the filled area by using an epoxy shield product. Material cost is approximately \$25.00 per gallon covering 250 square feet. Bernie Baker made a motion to spend up to \$150.00 for phase II for the project. Second by Kevin Hyde. Motion passed unanimously
