A Few Auction Facts:

Well, it's that time of year again that everyone is asking for your help with our auction. Our auctions started approximately 25 years ago, not only for our club, but for Byron's air show in Ida Grove Iowa back in the late 80's. We started in the community center (*Old Church*) in Springfield, Then moved to the Fairgrounds in Springfield, and after growing too large for the fairgrounds, Randy Tentinger hooked us up a few years ago with the good folks at BJSa where we are now residing.

Thus far we have mailed some 340 auction fliers in a mass mailing to area R/Cer's that cost us approximately \$135.00 just in postage. 700 total auction fliers were laser printed, with over 300 of them being distributed to the local Hobby Towns, Bud's Hobby, The Lincoln Sky Knights Auction, The Grand Island Auction, and the KCRC swapmeet in Kansas City. We have also organized and copied all of the needed auction paperwork.

Remember all of the funds generated by food & drink sales, and a portion of gate sales goes directly to the Bellevue Junior Sports Association a great Non-Profit organization for kids! They are really good folks! - Thank you BJSa!

We will be reorganizing the tables and check in area this year to try and smooth out the check in process. WRCF members can bring their items for sale to the auction set-up, Friday evening 7:00pm (4-21-06) to help smooth out the Saturday morning check in also. (Continued on page 3)

Our auction in the past has varied from some 250 to 400 items going across the auction block. Yes, it's a fairly large auction and year to year it varies. How many items this year? Your guess is as good as mine. That's one reason everyone is asking for your help.

There will be lot of moving items in set-up, moving items across the block, impounding, check in & out

The auction is our main source of income to be used for club events, field maintenance at *both* fields, *Porta-Pots*, general expenses, and of course, helps in keeping our annual dues low.

At 10 percent of all items sold, this adds up to a tidy sum. Last years auction, after expenses, generated some \$1450.00 in profits for the club. In the past it's been well over \$2000. This is a lot of improvements, event funding, promotion, and those low yearly dues. *Hey, not to mention those Tuesday Night Fun-Flys & Feeds!*

This year we also plan to have not only our normal Computer Radio Raffle at \$1.00 a ticket. We are holding a \$50.00 cash raffle **4-times** throughout the auction. Your \$5.00 admission gives you 2 free tickets for this raffle. (*Details on our auction flier*).

We also plan on including other donated items within this raffle. If you have a new item you would like to donate for the raffle contact Bob Boumstein.

We are also accepting donated R/C goods, new and used, to sell across the auction block with proceeds going to the club. If you want to donate items to the club for auction, *notify our sign up folks at the auction*, or an officer anytime.

If you can't spend all day, or both days helping, how about 2-3 hours? We can really use the help on Saturday the day of the auction. *Maybe your kids, grandkids, nephews, nieces can help?*

VEGAS ROLL!

Roll the dice & get a number 1 through 6, start your airplane, take off, fly 3 standard patterns (laps) around the field, land, and roll the dice until you land on your previously rolled number. Time starts at take off & ends at rolling correct number!. A partner may be used to control or retrieve the airplane once it's landed and stopped on runway.

Ties will be flown off until someone wins.

LOWEST TIME WINS!

BEANIE LOOPS!

Mount a paper cup to your airplane with Popsicle sticks and rubber bands. Place 5 beans in the cup, take off, do (1) loop and land. The most beans left in the cup wins.

Ties will be flown off until someone wins.

MOST BEANS LEFT IN THE CUP WINS!

CLIMB & GLIDE!

Take off, fly the pattern, when ready, fly by the start line and on go, start your climb as high as you can go in 30 seconds. (Timed) Go to low throttle & shut the engine off (Engine Must be off, and throttle advanced to prove it's off) Glide as long as possible to a dead stick landing. (Time starts at engine off, and stops at touch down.)
