# **Notice: Helicopter Flying**

Because some are still asking: Member concerns regarding helicopter flying at Springfield during the 2008 flying season led to the following rules being implemented:


- Helicopter flying at our Springfield Flying Field is strictly prohibited.
- Helicopter flying will be permitted at our Mead Flying Field. When both fixed wing airplanes and helicopters are at the Mead Flying Field, pilots should coordinate flying time with each other. Fixed wing flying will have priority at all times to use the runway and fixed wing flight patterns.

While prohibiting helicopter flying at Springfield, the club rules affirm the use of our Mead Field for helicopter flying.

# Flying Boundaries at Springfield

As a quick review, all club members should be aware of the court imposed flying boundaries at Springfield. More importantly, we must all abide by them or risk losing our field. Please study the maps. One other important note: no flying allowed before 12 noon on Sunday. Again, this is a court order mandate, and we want to be good neighbors.

# STEPS FOR AUCTION

#### Admittance

Entry into Firemen's Hall will require a <u>wrist band</u> issued at the door for \$5.00. Everyone must pay at the door. Only Exception will be 12 years of age and under.

#### Registration – Buyer/Seller

Admittance fee includes a buyer/seller registration <u>number</u> obtained with completion of registration card. Also includes one free raffle ticket. Register at first table inside.

#### • Seller Item Cards

While obtaining buyer/seller number, you may request <u>item cards</u> that you will fill out for each item to be auctioned. Request number of cards needed for your items.

#### Auction Items

Each item, or grouping of items, must have a minimum value of \$20.00 to be eligible for auctioning.

# **New Flying Season Prep**

Now that the flying season is here, some final touch up items that may need to be done.

Secure those loose edges of Monokote etc.
