Sorry I missed last month's meeting. I wasn't feeling very social at the time due to mine and Heather's \$5,000 lesson in trailer insurance. The lesson I learned is that everything of value has to have a separate insurance writer.

This prompted us to re-evaluate our property and it's insurance. We don't have receipts for everything we have, so we are making video documentary of items with estimated values as proof of ownership. I suggest that titles and certificates of origin be scanned and saved on a flash drive as well. As for insuring model airplanes, don't forget that AMA insurance is only supplementary. Homeowners insurance doesn't always cover theft away from the residence.

In these economic times I would suggest that you keep a close eye on all your stuff when at the airfield. Thieves lurk in crowds. If you don't need it out then put it in your vehicle and lock it up. Locks only keep honest people honest, insurance takes care of the rest, as long as you have it. If you have anything of substantial value, you may want to set up a meeting with your insurance agent. Please share your insurance findings so we can pass it on to those who need to know.

Show N' Tell at February Meeting

This winter we have had some interesting projects brought to the meetings for Show N' Tell. **Fred Becker** has proven to be a prolific builder of his own design models. Not to be undone at the last meeting, Fred brought along his Micro Fighter ducted fan jets. Yes, made of foam. The foam he used was that purchased at Menards, and sold as attic roof vent spacers.



These models have aileron and elevator control. Fred had not yet flown them at the time brought to the meeting. The small jet uses a 6mm pager motor 4.1v, in a stock Air Hog 30mm EDF fan. 22g AUW w/battery, 18g without. 10" wingspan. The larger jet uses a 12mm motor, 7.2v, flat can motor. Mounted in a stock Silverlit (Air Hogs) e-charger EDF from a free flight plane. It has 40g AUW with battery, 32g without. 11.5" wingspan.



The sheet of foam Fred used to build these models can be seen on the table. He actually used the preformed "V" to make the top of the fuselages.

Joey Thompson brought the fuse of his Hangar 9 Mustang. He had some questions that he bounced off the group. He is used an electric motor for power.

Bob Burt's PBY Project

Bob's PBY was built from plans over the winter. Plans came from Classic Plans Service. The wingspan is 72 inches with power from two Turnigy C3542-1100 electric motors. The ESC used is also a Turnigy rated at 40 amps with 5,000 mah battery. Bottom of fuselage is fiberglassed and the entire model is covered with Monokote. Bob says: "No water rudder, so I will have to figure how to control it on the water." This is a water version of the BPY and no landing gear installed. Paint scheme was taken from a book that depicted the PBY in an Air Force air, sea, rescue version.







Props used on this twin engine PBY are Master airscrew 8x6, one regular and one pusher.
