to Dec 31st of each year. You must have a valid AMA card to renew. Two or three clubs jointly use the field but no affiliation is required. I met several of the guys and made 1 or 2 acquaintances that I think have potential. I

flew my Quaker and Goldberg Sailplane there several times and struggled with my Heli also. The runway is huge and wide and concrete. The facility has a covered area to rest at and a permanent Port a Potty for the needy. The ranger is there on the weekend to DB



test airplanes but he is liberal. The field is about 3 miles from the mountains and affords no hassles to either side or in front, houses are a block away in the rear. I believe the noises are zero back behind I never hear anything upon my approach driving in. The guys fly a lot of large (30%) stuff and lot of electrics 15 to 40 size and a few Ducted fan electrics too. I have seen four or five Helis also, everyone plays nicely together.

Back on the home front; I am willing to fly indoors on Thursday if others want to. Dean C. says it has fallen off with the flying season in swing, what season, Wind, Rain, Skeerters! OK it is Nebraska!

Apologies to any of you who have been inconvenienced by "bad weather" days in that you showed up at Mead only to find nobody there even on the Tuesday evenings.


It has been proposed that there be a "rain date" for those Tuesdays that become questionable. The new date would be the following day. The weekly flying, drinks, and food would be postponed until then.
