Here's a bit of story about a plane that I have which had a wing incidence issue. I purchased this plane at an auction. It had been broken up somewhat, and then repaired.

Following the repairs to the plane, there was one wing half that was not exactly even with the other. Meaning one wing was twisted more than the other. I needed a device to adjust my plane's wing incidence. I did not have one and could not find an article on how to build it or to be able to purchase a such a device that would fit my plane. So I built one from



solid wood and included a long bolt through it. It was made of 1/2" thick bass wood with a 10x32 bolt and nut. After multiple flights and adjustments I got this dialed in very well. I thought that I would pass this

design on and maybe this would help someone else.

We extended an invitation to the members of area RC clubs, whose fields have been flooded, to fly at our Mead Field. This was a good will gesture. Several of the impacted flyers have already expressed their appreciation. I hope to see some of the flooded flyers out at the field with our group real soon.

This summer, several Omaha area RC clubs were impacted severely by the Missouri River flooding. Their fields are still



very wet or under water rendering them unusable and leaving many without a place to fly for the summer. A few weeks ago, **Bob Boumstein** proposed that these flooded out flyers be offered

permission to fly at our Mead Field. Further, that we allow them to fly at our field at no cost through November 1st. There were provisions such as flyers holding a current membership with the affected club, paid-up dues with AMA for 2011, no helicopter flying, and the need to abide by Western RC Flyers club rules. This proposal was put before our club officers and board members. It was passed and the invitation extended. (copy included on this page.) Many of the flooded out flyers have expressed their gratitude for allowing use of our Mead Field, and wish to pass that on to you.

It was really difficult to get any flying in during the month of July. Sporadic thunderstorms did us in, as well as the brutal heat. There was very little flying. Let's hope August brings us better flying weather.

#### Flying & Flooding

The Western R/C Flyers Club, by approval of its officers and board members, wishes to extend their hands in friendship to:

The offer is that members of these clubs (providing both their membership card and an AMA card) will be able to use the Western Flyer Field in Mead NE. This offer is good through the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2011. No membership fee in the Western R/C Flyers is required.

The Western R/C Flyers ask that the following rules be followed, with the understanding that violators will be asked to leave and not fly there again:

- 1. All field rules as posted will be adhered.
- 2. The Mead field is for model airplanes only; helicopters are not welcome at Mead.
- 3. Courtesy during field use is a must, as well as sharing the field with all other flyers.
- 4. Trash to be removed by all flyers.
- 5. No open flying during scheduled events (consult the Western Flyers Newsletter for event dates and times).

### **ROAD TO MEAD FIELD**

Trouble getting to the field? At the Town of Mead corner on Highway 92, turn south driving 3.7 miles on the hard surfaced county road to a dirt access road leading to field. Turn east here in direction of water tower, then take very short winding road to east side of long white warehouse building. See aerial below. However be advised that there are 3 routes from the county road into Mead Field. Those are shown on enlarged aerial to the right.

Primary route into the field is the **dirt road**, unless conditions are too wet. Route "A" is an improved gravel road few hundred yards south of the dirt road turnoff that takes you through the university facility. Continuing further south on the county road is alternative route "B" (addt'l 2.5 miles) that is a hard surfaced road on 3 of its legs. On last leg, turn at the white block building and follow road around to field.
