November Show N' Tell



Rick Johnson brought his own design and scratch-built electric model. Made of EPP foam with carbon fiber reinforcement rods in the wings. Control is with elevator and ailerons only. A very light airplane that is fully aerobatic.



Picking up a bargain off the internet, **Bob Burt** found a micro chopper with transmitter for \$17.99 shipped. It has coaxial blades, and signal is transmitted by infra red. It has a 3.7v lipo battery that can be recharged through the transmitter or the USB port on your PC. Bob still needed to master the flying of this helicopter at the time of the meeting. But he thinks it was a good purchase and a quality built model. Note: This helicopter was available at NewEgg.com for \$22.50 shipped.
