- Clean up any planes you want to sell, repairing the tears in the covering and shinning them up with car wax does help. After all it is what people see that motivates them.
- I believe it is best to separate the engine and radio from the plane as not everyone likes the same thing.
   Generally you will get more out of it if you do this.
- Putting items like radios and engines in the original box really does help get a better price.
- Put a minimum price (if you need to) on your seller's card, keeping it at the least you would take for the items.
- Remember nobody will pay retail for anything, so when pricing be realistic.
