

January Show N' Tell


An 80" twin engine amphibian under construction by **Bob Burt** was shown to us. It is a Widgeon that Bob is building from a set of Vintage RC Plans. In the third photo he is demonstrating how the "mechanical" retracts operate with a socket driver. Bob has a pair of Enya .80 four strokes he will use. It will be equipped with operating navigation lights. Nine servos total.













Above you see **Bob Rogge** with his scratch built 1916 Vickers FB5 Gunbus. The model spans 36" and weighs 11 ounces. Covering used is Hallmark tissue paper with Pactra paint. Following the last two Thursdays at the Center, Bob has determined that the Vickers is underpowered and needs a bigger electric motor. Nice detail with the model!

A small foamy Hobby King ELC Spitfire with brushless motor was shown by **Rick Johnson**. It is very light weight at 82 grams, and probably ideal for indoor flying with its 16"wingspan.



Fred Becker brought two of his projects to the meeting. They were a barebones 1937 Moth Minor built from plans. It weighs 20 grams empty, and 40 grams with power. The other was an A-10 Warthog that Fred is testing for a company in China. It has built-in outrunners powering the ducted fans. Anticipated weight is 160 grams flyable.









A most unusual engine was brought to the meeting by **Bob Boumstein**. An open rocker arm/push rod Saito .40 four stroke vintage 1975-80. Bob also showed his cheap but quality pocketcam that he will mount on his airplanes.





A barebones fuselage held by **Nelson Carpenter** is of the Balsa USA 1/4 scale Cub. He is converting 104" span model into an L4J Grasshopper complete with "greenhouse" behind cabin. It will be powered by a Saito 1.50 four-stroke and has a target weight of 15 pounds.
