<u>Tim Peters:</u> Tim is going to be doing an RC/Aviation discovery class for an OPS school. Tim was once a teacher so he is excited to work with the students about the hobby. Way to go Tim!!!

<u>Dean Copeland</u>: Dean brought in an electric starter that he ordered from China. It is made to start most RC engines. It is very light. He uses a Lipo 14.8v battery for power and it has plenty of torque with this setup.

<u>Jim Welshon:</u> Jim brought in a *Seagull CAP 232* ARF he is putting together this winter. Dimensions: Wingspan: 65"; Wing Loading: 28 oz/sq ft.; Engine: He plans to use an OS .91; Receiver: Spektrum; On-board glow: Hangar 9.

<u>Rick Johnson</u>: Rick brought in a <u>Blade mCPx V2</u> micro helicopter he received as a Christmas gift. It is the Bind-N-Fly version for Spektrum radios. It has the AS3X stabilization system which helps while flying. The helicopter is incredibly light and surprisingly durable.

Sig 1/3rd Scale Spacewalker By Jim Henley Part I



I started the 1/3 scale *Spacewalker* on Saturday January 12th. First, I marked all the plywood pieces according to the die cut guide, and built all the required sub assemblies. That followed with pinning the lower spar to the plan, and adding the wing ribs.

There are 3 different ribs. So I had to check the rib numbers against the plan, then pin the ribs in place. After the ribs are pinned to the plan, I made sure they were at 90 degrees to the spar then tacked them with "CA". Next the upper spar and leading edge were added. Then the wing joiners and their mounts, as well as the shear webs along the front top and bottom spars.


Cap strips are glued to the ribs. Then leading and trailing edge sheeting are added. Removed the wing from the plan and added rib caps, L.E. and T.E. sheeting to wings. At this point we cut the center section from each of the wings. After sanding the center ribs smooth and flush, the center sections are glued with epoxy and clamped together. The center section still needs dihedral braces #3 & #4 added. Remaining shear webs are glued in and top will be sheeted. Next time we will be framing out the fuselage of the Spacewalker.






