December Show N' Tell

First to present his project was **Bob Turner** with a discus-type glider called a "<u>SuperGee II</u>." Discus because you launch it into the air by the wingtip like a discus thrower. With a wingspan of 59" it weighed a mere 8 ounces with four servos, and a 200 mAh battery pack. It is made of carbon fiber and Kevlar for a strong light aircraft. It really floats too!!













Above you see **Bob Boumstein** assembling his "Vector" kite with the able assistance of **Steve Peck**. As strange as it might appear, this "kite" is an agile flyer with an articulating motor located in the center of the aircraft. **Bob** purchased this from an eBay seller, and he's quite happy with it. Unfortunately **Bob** forgot to charge the batteries, and we were not able to see it demonstrated. No, it doesn't require a kite string.

December Show N' Tell Cont....

A most unusual project being built for this year's Top Gun Invitational was shown by **Dean Copeland**. The twin engine "Cri-Cri" (Cricket in French) is being built at 50 percent scale from the exact plans and drawings of the full scale aircraft. That results in a wingspan of 100 inches. It will weigh 22 lbs when completed. Power is with two AXI 4120-18 electric motors using a 7S4P A-123 battery. The two motors will swing 13X8 propellers. A very interesting project that hopefully we'll see more of at Show N' Tell as Dean progresses. To learn more, attend the next few meetings.







