Dec 2013 Meeting Notes



(9) members present

Called to order by Jim Henley

Preceding meeting topics, condolences were expressed for the passing of long-time club member **Jim Albin**. Jim was an active member of the club and well liked.

Dean Copeland presented Treasurer's report.

Discussion items:

• Proposals for increasing club revenue:

<u>Dues increase</u> - After discussion the general feeling was that dues should not be increased.

<u>Discontinue Meeting Drawing</u> - It was agreed upon that the \$25.00 drawing for those bringing *Show N' Tell* items to the meetings be discontinued at a savings to the club. There will no longer be a drawing.

<u>Fees for flying events</u> - Possibly set the landing fees up in such a way to provide incentive for non-members to join *Western Flyers*.

<u>Donations</u> - Accept donations for lunch at flying events to cover such expense.

<u>Membership drive</u> - Maybe include incentive (*cash reward*) for existing members to sign up new members.

<u>Club Raffle</u> - Talk with **Ed Paasch** about fund raising—he has successfully assisted other clubs with such.

<u>Field Finder's Fee</u> - Western Flyers' web site had been promoting a 'finder's fee' for assistance in locating an additional flying site for several years now. It was agreed that this should be removed. **Dean Copeland** to discuss with **Joe Halamek** (web master) regarding getting this removed.

<u>Club Budget</u> - **Dean Copeland** indicated that he will project income and expenses for 2014 and will present during the January meeting. It was moved and approved to defer further discussion re: budget until January meeting.

• Field Maintenance:

Discussion on repair of the 'dip' at the south end of the field. Jim Henley will speak with Bill Davis regarding equipment for making repairs to the field. Bill Davis had indicated that he would assist with operating the equipment if the club provides it. This discussion centered around the need or not to repair the dip. Instead perhaps focus on establishing good stand of grass.

The club needs to hear back from **Bob Burt** about his conversation with the manager **Lanny** of the research station at Mead about how best to perform field maintenance.

Repairing/replacing the door on the equipment shed. Leroy Konecky to identify options including use of a steel door, and report back next meeting. Jim Henley reported that the shed has a newly revamped roof.

Some discussion about moving the pilot set-up stands, and putting them under cover until spring. Determined not necessary.

The club has (2) additional lawn mowers that could be put up for sale. It was mentioned keeping one as a spare might be wise

There was talk about whether water is available for irrigation use on our field at Mead from the existing hydrants. Leroy Konecky to check into it.

Events for 2014

Event dates need to be finalized by 2/1/2014. View Tailspin newsletter schedule page regarding events and identify specific dates.

Jim Henley will discuss with IMAA regarding sanction for Bud Hall event. Benefit of sanction is additional advertising in IMAA newsletter in addition with that provided in AMA magazine.

How to encourage attendance at monthly meetings. Some ideas were discussed. Tim Peters volunteered to contact members by phone to remind them about the January meeting — to call one week before meeting date. Nelson Carpenter to provide Tim Peters with member addresses and phone numbers.

Meeting adjourned 8:10 PM.

Building Up-North Country

I can report to you after several recent phone calls and e-mails from Jim Drickey up in Longville, Minnesota, that he is making good progress with his Newport 17. This model hasn't taken him more than a month to get where it is today. But perhaps needless-to-say, Jim is sort of snowed in with the winter up there.



When I expressed amazement that he had gotten so far in a short period of time, he remarked: "What?.....do you think I just threw magic beans down stairs and this thing appeared? Oh contraire my friend, you have to go down in the work room and make it happen." Although I think he does have magic beans.

The Newport 17 is a Balsa USA kit with 55 in. wingspan. It will be powered by an OS .40 four stroke. This is Jim's first time using Solartex, and he says it seems to be a fine product. Although "pricey", it has the appearance of cloth and is strong. With the firewall on, his next step is to paint the cowl and wheels a medium blue.


