Reminder, if the ground is wet at Mead and surrounding area, then you can expect the dirt road from the county highway into the field to be wet. Take the next improved road that's about 1/4 mile further south on the county highway. Turn east there. You'll recognize where you are once arriving at the long white building. The flying field is on the opposite side of that building. Also, take care as you drive into the pits. Try your best not to create or enlarge any ruts with your vehicle. Usually those roads are dried out in a day or two. But since we're entering a drought, you can ignore for now what I said about the wet roads.

Rumors, Gossip and other Signs of Decay


A couple of weeks ago I went to the club's Spring Fun Fly. The
