By the way, the grass field at Springfield is in very good condition following it being rolled. The same is true of Mead I am told. So see you at Mead on the 7th!

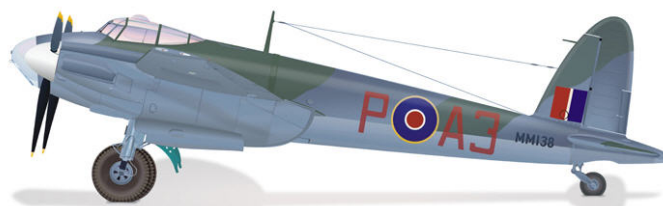

It was also reported that we have purchased a new mower for the Springfield flying field. The new mower purchased was a Sears Craftsman 46" rider. The purchase was well below the approved budget, saving us several hundred dollars towards future purchases for field improvements.

Next call to order was the treasurer's report which was revamped into a more comprehensive and understandable report by Treasurer Ed Splittgerber. The new report states where each and every penny has gone. Great thanks to Ed for modernizing our treasurer's report format. Motion made, seconded, and passed to accept the treasurer's report for May 2008.

Next call to order was new business which began with discussion about the Porta-Johns. Motion made, seconded, and passed to get the Porta-Johns and to have Rick take care of it. Take care of getting the Johns in place, that is to say.

There was extensive discussion on ideas for next year's auction. Several ideas were brought up, however none were decided upon. It was agreed to table discussions about the auction for the remainder of the flying season. With that, all ideas were laid to rest at this point in time.

President Rick Miller reviewed the upcoming events in order to get the logistics figured out and to gather info on any needs for all of our flying evenings for the current flying season.

Discussion was made as far as condition of the lawn equipment at Mead. A motion was made, seconded, and declined for spending \$300 to repair equipment at Mead. However a motion was made, seconded and passed to spend \$200 on equipment repairs. Any repairs over that amount to be decided by the club president.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:58 PM.

should come out fine.

Several guys locally have asked me what is it I sell, and why? Well I sell model airplane engines. All types from parts engines to collectables. Part of what I do is estate sales for people who have lost a modeler in their family. I charge 15% on consignment and give the rest (85%) to the family. Everyone

I started this about 23 years ago after becoming a partner in buying several thousand Cox engines that were basically factory returns. We sold most of them to the Australian school system. Then I sold them 3 for \$10 and \$2 shipping they went like hotcakes. It gave me a couple of bucks to fund the idea. My plan was to sell mostly usable engines as there were several guys already selling collectable ones.

As time went by it became clear to me for the need for "junkyard" type motors so guys could tear them up to get the parts you need. You will find many engines price from \$9 to \$24 in this range. Realize that the manufacturers get big bucks for parts. An engine would cost at least 5 times its retail value if bought part by part. So now I am the junkman I have about 300 mufflers, 400 carbs, but sell most of these of my list or on eBay. Sorry to say I am not set up to have people come over to look around. Locally I accommodate the few people that want something by bringing it to our office on Deauville Drive. Hopefully this gives everyone a picture of my goofy deal.
