# Show N' Tell at February Meeting

We had one project presented at the last meeting that was simply outstanding. Fresh off the building table **Fred Becker** (below) brought his newest creation. Seems to be one-a-month out of **Fred**. It is a scratch built WWI bomber of sorts. It was designed and built out of his imagination and desire to use a gutted Air Hogs power system of twin pusher motors. Fred's design parameters: Twin pusher (Gotha), use an Air Hogs Aero Ace system, have thrust vectored, and create something cooler.



Fred says: "The B.A.D. Bomber is a one-off, own design, guess we can classify it as a 'Fantasy Scale. My motivation is the Gotha, Vickers Vimy, and DH-4, all rolled into one."






The Air Hog "organ donor" provided 10 grams of motors, props, lipo, receiver, switch, and charging jack!



With airframe, electronics, paint, decals, landing gear, machine guns, rigging, and some ballast, Fred says he is at 26 1/2 to 27 grams. (*Tell me that isn't lighter than a feather!!*)




A pencil really demonstrates the size of this model.




Twin pusher Gotha Bomber: One of the inspirations for Fred's model design/build.



Check closely for the details of this model such as the guns and flying wires.




Note the flying wires. Everything on this model was scratch built. Below are the delicate balsa parts mostly made out of 1/32nd sheet balsa.





The bomber has a 12" wingspan and wing area of 48 Sq In. Props are 1-3/4" in diameter each.



Fred says: "Figure these planes fly a good 6+ minutes if you use a lot of throttle. So on the little 135 mah one cell, it is using about 100 mah during this time at 3.9 V average (WOT). It's just amazing how the little micro planes use so little energy for flight."
