<u>VEGAS ROLL!</u>

Roll the dice & get a number 1 through 6, start your airplane, take off, fly 3 standard patterns (laps) around the field, land, and roll the dice until you land on your previously rolled number. Time starts at take off & ends at rolling correct number!. A partner may be used to control or retrieve the airplane once it's landed and stopped on runway.

Ties will be flown off until someone wins.

LOWEST TIME WINS!

BEANIE LOOPS!

Mount a paper cup to your airplane with Popsicle sticks and rubber bands. Place 5 beans in the cup, take off, do (1) loop and land. The most beans left in the cup wins. Ties will be flown off until someone wins.

MOST BEANS LEFT IN THE CUP WINS!

CLIMB & GLIDE!

Take off, fly the pattern, when ready, fly by the start line and on go, start your climb as high as you can go in 30 seconds. (Timed) Go to low throttle& shut the engine off (Engine Must be off, and throttle advanced to prove it's off) Glide as long as possible to a dead stick landing. (Time starts at engine off, and stops at touch down.)

Ties will be flown off until someone wins.
