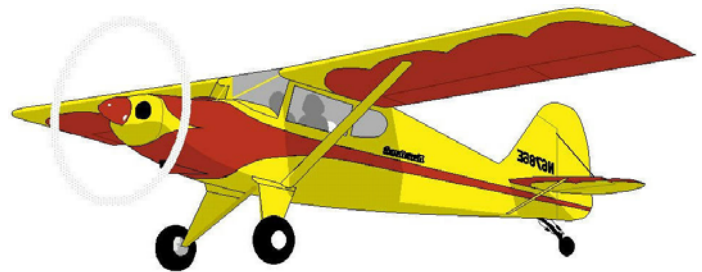

A motion was passed to reimburse Bob Boumstein the fuel cost for use of his vehicle and trailer for transporting the roller.

As far as new business is concerned, discussion was heard on how to reduce the number of returned auction flyers that are mailed out. One suggestion that was accepted is to get e-mail addresses, and that would save on postage next year as well.

Ed Splittgerber reported on radios available to purchase for the raffle. Our Hobbytown credit would be used to offset the cost. The club voted to purchase the Futaba 6EX FSST radio.

Ed also reported that we had purchased the computer auction program and discussed whether or not we needed to make available additional computers for the auction.

Motion was made and passed to continue with the numbered item stickers for the auction. Bob Burt volunteered to be the person to put stickers on the auction items.

Discussion was held on making a sign for the entrances of both fields to inform people that we are a members only club and that without membership not to trespass. It was suggested that the signs say "WRCF Members Only". Dean Copeland volunteered to have the signs made.

Discussion was also heard concerning an individual non-member who has been intruding on the Springfield site. This person usually shows up on Sunday mornings. Beyond that, flying is not allowed before noon on Sundays. *If any member observes this person at the field, try to get his name and vehicle license number.* Then please discretely report him to the Sarpy County Sheriff and have him escorted off the field.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:37 P.M.

Approximately 22 club members were present at the April meeting which focused on the auction activities and organization. Yet we had two show n' tell projects presented to the group.



Bob Burt brought a plane from out of the past. The classic Joe Bridi Kaos was designed as a sport pattern plane back in 1970. It has a wingspan of 59 inches and a length of 55 inches. It is meant for a .60 size two stroke engine. Bob told us that his intent was to get it covered and ready for the April 19th auction. But he first wanted to get one flight on it. This is one nice airplane that somebody is happy to have bought at the auction by the time you read this newsletter.

Dustin Anderson brought this large box to the meeting for Show N' Tell. Of course we all knew right away that it contained an



airplane of sorts. But the reason behind the box was that he wished to surprise his better half **Jennifer** for her birthday. Opening the box revealed to Jennifer and the rest of us the Modeltech Dragon Lady ARF. She was truly surprised and happy to get it. We can expect to see it ready and flying at our next gathering at Springfield. The Dragon Lady is a sharp looking ARF has balsa sheeted foam core wings. It is entirely covered with Monokote with a factory-painted cowl. Wingspan is 66 inches and powered by a .60 to .90 glow engine. It takes four servos and setup as a tail dragger. Jennifer should easily be able to fly this plane given the number of flight simulator hours she has in front of their widescreen television.
