2005 Membership dues:

2005 memberships are now available as of October 1st. If you know of anyone that would like to join our club, they can join now and fly the rest of the year (2004) on their 2005 membership card. Here's a great way to get your 3 new member referrals for the sign 3, fly free in 2005 program. Only a few more months to get new members to sign up, that's right if you sign up 3 new members in 2004, you fly free (No club dues) in 2005. You must have your name on the referral portion of the membership form to receive credit. Get to work, I want to see all of you flying free next year. 2005 Annual Auction:

We have reserved the BJSA building for April 23rd 2005 to hold our annual auction. I will try to have flyers available at the October meeting. We need to tell all of our friends and advertise this as much as possible, it is our main income for the club and needs to be as successful as in past years.

Springfield Compliance Checks:

We are currently monitoring and doing field rule compliance checks, such as membership cards, airplane noise levels, verifying "NO ACTIVITY" during "Field Closed" times and other field rules. Some of which are listed below.

The field is "CLOSED" with "NO ACTIVITY" from dark until 9am Monday through Saturday, and dark until 12Noon Sundays. The field is "CLOSED" again at 6pm Sunday evening with "NO ACTIVITY", NO EXCEPTIONS! (It is a very serious violation of club rules to be on the field during the "closed" times.)

All Non-member pilots <u>must</u> be accompanied by a <u>card</u> <u>carrying</u> Western R/C Flyer member and are limited to 3 visits. (*Non-members using our facilities without permission will not be tolerated.*)

AMA Guidelines for noise will be used, contact us if you would like to have your aircraft tested, we will be setting up some testing dates during the October meeting. (Aircraft must test equal to, or lower than the AMA guideline of 98 db to fly at Springfield.)

Read, re-read, and understand the complete field rules, they are in place for a reason and are expected to be followed by everyone. They are posted on our web site, are available at our meetings, and available upon request. Please do not take it personally if we happen to ask for your membership card or a db reading on your aircraft, we are just trying to maintain the integrity of our flying site. If you have any questions, concerns, or if you require clarification of the rules, please feel free to contact myself or any officer at any time. **Thanks & we appreciate everyone's cooperation!**

Scale Fun Fly and Show & Shine:

We had a great turnout for the scale meet this year with 18 registered pilots and 25 or so airplanes. The wind was up, but did not keep everyone on the ground.
