It was bought out by a business person with no hobby knowledge who



just wanted to sell stuff, but offered no services. My friends at *Cutting Edge Hobbies*, in North Las Vegas, are trying to pick up the slack. They do understand to make a

difference in today's market, a hobby shop must do more than sell stuff. If you offer services such as engine repair, and some basic soldering of connectors (i.e. Deans plugs) for those wanting or needing help, you're more likely to attract customers. The internet probably accounts for more than 80% of airplane modelers' purchases today. If a retailer offers a gathering spot for modelers to converge (remember Bud's?), and some services they might have a chance.

I will be involved in the shop out there in the



fall, as I am renting a display case for engines and miscellaneous items. *Cutting Edge Hobbies* is willing to service airplane customers along with the RC car base and helicopter stuff they currently

stock. I hope to do some serious hanging out there a few afternoons a week. I will try to help airplane guys where I can, as I am not an expert in any aspect. I might have to call some.....

....of you from time to consult. But the fact is that I really hate to see the hobby shops go away. I long for the days of *Bud's*

FEATURED PHOTO FACT SHEET

The C-47 with tail number EN770 was an AC-47 gunship in the Vietnam war; one with a rather remarkable history.

"Following the melee that was the Tet Offensive, AC-47s returned to more routine defensive and interdiction missions. During the night of February 28, 1968, Nha Trang-based Spooky EN-770 was hit in the right wing by a VC mortar just as Sergeant John Levitou was preparing to throw a flare overboard. Shrapnel from the impact severely wounded Levitou and caused the flare to drop inside the fuselage, arming itself in the process. Realizing the dire consequence should the flare ignite when its safe-separation time expired, Levitou crawled to the armed flare and managed to throw it out the open cargo door just before it ignited explosively under the aircraft's tail. For his valor, Sergeant Levitou was awarded the Medal of Honor," (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/John_Levitow)
