

Allan asked if any present were AMA Leader Members and if we received a letter encouraging us to coordinate with AMA if our flying field was within an airports-controlled airspace.


The meeting adjourned around 7:15 pm.

Tom Wild's "0 Four9ier" is a semi-scale model of the RF-4 motor glider. Tom built it from plans originally published in the 1992 British publication Radio Modeller. Peter Miller designed the plane. The plans are available on several Internet sites such as https://aerofred.com/search.php? show result=1&page=3

Instead of using an .049 IC engine, Tom substituted a Himax HC2808-0980 motor. The plane fight controls are limited to ailerons and elevator. The rudder is fixed which Tom is considering making controllable if he builds another one.
