

Fellow Omahawk's:

We are pleased to announce that the runway resurfacing has been completed!

You are cleared to fly again!

Just a few things to keep in mind:

1. The runway has been leveled and therefore has some higher edges now (up to about 4" in some places). Therefore, it is NOT recommended that if you run off the edge, to try and get back on the runway remotely. Go pick up your model. We can see how this works and decide if we want to use some fill dirt and re-seed the edges.
2. The lines have not yet been painted. This work will be scheduled soon, including the 60 deg. pattern plane lines and pit area lines.
3. There is dirt/mud on both ends of the runway, so again, don't try to remotely bring your model back, just go pick it up.
4. The secondary safety fence has been removed. Do not taxi your planes more that you need to get the tail past the primary safety fence, then pick up your plane to return to the pits.
5. While 90% of the field work is done, we still have several smaller projects to complete including: Kiosk, wind sock, security cameras (fake), rut filling, port-a-potty enclosure, and wood steps behind bleachers repaired.

Come out and fly! You will be impressed with the new runway!
