CLUB FLYING FIELD AMENITIES:

The MILE-HI field is a first class flying facility. It has a Geotextile runway which is 600 ft X 60 Ft. Plenty of runway for the large planes. A covered transmitter impound board is available for safe keeping of radios. Sheltered pilot and picnic areas provide plenty of shade. For safety reasons a designated engine start up complete with start up benches area has been provided. A pit area with numerous workbenches is available to make setting up your airplane as easy as possible. Designated parking and camping space surrounds the fenced flying site. A portable toilet is located at the field.

Prizes and Participation Rules:

Fly-In awards will be presented for a Pilots Choice, and Best Warbird. In order to participate the rules are simple! Just bring any legal airplane to the FLY-IN and have it displayed throughout the day on the flight line for pilots to see. Fly it whenever you feel like it. Participating pilots will receive one ticket to vote during registration and are encouraged to take the time and wait for all participants to register. Once the pilots briefing has been finalized, pilots can cast their vote any time of the day. This FLY-IN has generated numerous participants from clubs around the region and we encourage everyone to come out and show off their airplanes. The rules have been kept simple and relaxed. Come and enjoy our excellent flying facility. You might even run into one of your old friends. During the day, an abundance of additional door prizes will be given away!

Flying Field Directions:

The Mile Hi R/C flying site is located east of Aurora, CO on Quincy Avenue approximately 18 miles East of E-470. From I-225 take Parker Road Exit, go south to Quincy Avenue; go east 4 miles past the E-470 underpass at Gun Club Road for another 18.5 miles. Continue onto the dirt at the Kiowa-Bennett Road just over 2 miles. Look for the flying field on the North (Left side) of the road.

From I-70 East Bound:

Take Exit 305 Kiowa-Bennett Road. Proceed approximately 8 miles south to CR 30 (Quincy Avenue Four Way Stop) (Look for CR 30 sign on east side). (Also known as Quincy Avenue) Turn left (East) on CR 30 and drive just over 2 miles. Look for the flying field on the North (Left) side of the road

From I-70, Westbound:

Take Exit 306 (Rest Area). At the stop sign, go west towards Bennett to bottom of the hill. Turn left (south) on to the Kiowa-Bennett Rd and drive south for approximately 8 miles to CR 30 (Look for CR 30 sign on east side). (Also known as Quincy Avenue) Turn left (East) on CR 30 and drive just over 2 miles. Look for the flying field on the North (Left) side of the road.
